Today was the third of our four Sundays at HTC focused on our "A Vision for Life" sermon series.

If you were at one of our four services today, you will know how I was speaking about HTC's **inspiring past and our exciting future** as we listen to God's "words of life".

Particularly, I painted a **three-year vision** for HTC - **2026 which will be 250 years since the church was built**. This vision includes: **900** people at church on a Sunday, **300** people doing Alpha in a year, **3** new church plants/renewals and the completion of our Revitalise 250 building project. We both want to thank you so much for all the ways you have been supporting the vision of the church over the past year, and we want to encourage you to visit avisionforlife.org to see all the suggested ways you might like to respond to this sermon series.

There are plenty of things to sign up for or book onto on this web page, but I'll just mention the two main applications from my talk today.

EVERYONE GIVE

Thank you so much for your part in giving financially to the work of HTC. Next year's expenditure at HTC will be around £1.3m. To meet this, **our giving needs to increase by around £80,000**. Our hope is that if you are not yet giving to HTC, you might set up your giving to the church's general funds. Click [here](#) to do this, and through lots of new givers, we pray we will meet this £80,000 additional cost for 2024.

However, the **even bigger need** is for the rest of the amount for the [Revitalise 250](#) building project. Currently, as a congregation we have raised **£4m of the £5.8m project** which is a major answer to prayer. If you currently already give to HTC's general funds, we would like to encourage you to keep giving at the same level, but then consider giving additionally specifically for Revitalise 250, either via a regular monthly donation or via a one-off sum. It would be so helpful for our financial planning if you are able to pray through and set up your giving in the next 10 days.
