

READ together Psalm 1

David, Harrie and Sam all talked about having a Christ-like attitude in their workplace. In Psalm 1 there is a clear contrast between those who walk in God's ways and those who do not. This Psalm talks about our thinking, our behaviour, and our belonging (vv. 1-2).

- Q1. Was there anything in the video which encouraged you as an example of how to walk in God's ways in relation to media, the arts, or your workplace?
- Q2. What does it mean to 'delight' in God's law? What is God's best for you?

David, Harrie and Sam spoke about trusting in God's plan, and making the most of the opportunities and the challenges of this season. It may not always be obvious at the outset how we might bear fruit for Jesus, but in the Psalm the tree has leaves which do not wither (v. 3).

- ⇒ Q3. What feeds your spiritual life? Do you know that you are planted by streams of water?
- ⇒ Q4. How have you experienced God's fruitfulness in your life in different seasons?
- Q5. Has the pandemic affected your trust in God's plan, or are you able to testify to God's hand on your journey like Harrie and Sam?

PRAY

'The Lord watches over the way of the righteous' (v. 6) – spend some time in prayer committing your plans to God and praying for one another, claiming this promise. Why not also pray for the media sphere at this time, to be filled with God's life, rather than mockery or cynicism.
